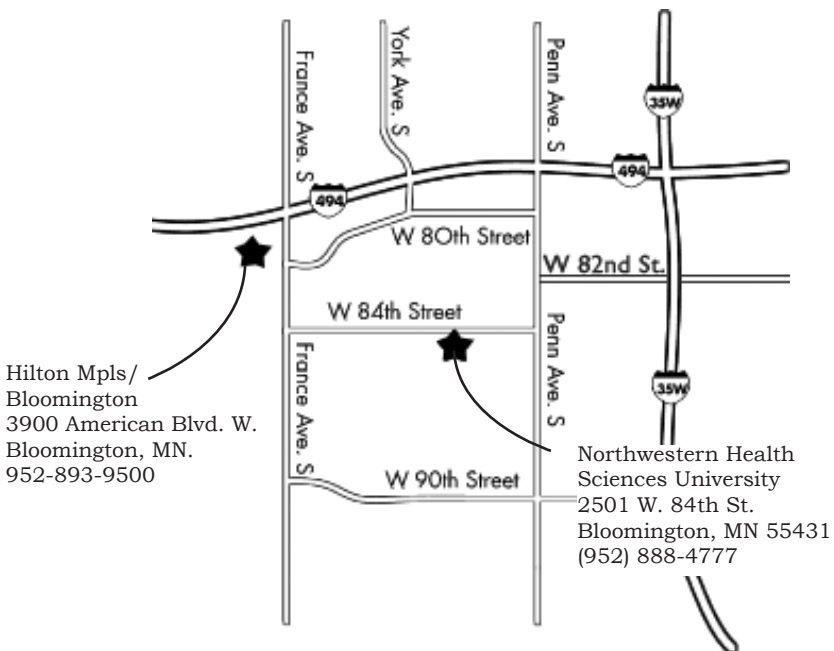
Show location:
