

MINNESOTA PORCELAIN ART SCHOOL - A NEW SETTING IN 2008

Minnesota Porcelain Artists are pleased to present the 2008 Porcelain Art School with four exceptional teachers and projects. Join us for this wonderful painting experience. All levels of students are welcome. If you are currently not a member of the MPAG your school registration includes a membership fee of \$20.00. This entitles you to all mailings and privileges. A colored photo of COMPARABLE work by the instructors is pictured to help with your choices as well as a brief description of the project.

Location: Christ the King Lutheran Church, 1900 NW 7th St., New Brighton, MN 651-633-6474.

Dates: 1st 3 day session - July 24, 25 and 26 (Thurs, Fri & Sat)

2nd 3 day session - July 28, 29 and 30 (Mon, Tues & Wed)

Please select your choice (1st, etc.) of classes from the enclosed roster of teachers and dates. If you take a second class, it will be offered at a 10% discount on the second class. Waiting lists will be started for all full classes. Class placement will be based on date of postmark. Guild member registrations may not be postmarked before March 15, 2008, non member registrations may not be postmarked before March 29, 2008. The class maximum is set for ten students. It is preferred that all registrations are completed by June 1, 2008 to allow time for the instructors to purchase china and paint for use in class; although we will keep registrations open until the school starts. Note you have an option to bring your china in some of the projects; however please be careful in your choices so that you have a good result.

Cancellation/Refund Policy: Refunds will be given without question until May 15, 2008. After that date, your class will be offered to the waiting list first, or you may find a replacement after that. However, refunds are available for emergencies, on a case by case basis. A retention fee of \$10.00 applies to all cancellations.

LUNCHES: No lunch facility is available on site. It is OK to bring your own lunch.

In early May you will be notified of acceptance of your application and class choice. In June you will receive further details of your class(s). You may purchase your china from the instructor or bring your own, be sure to indicate which on the registration sheet. You must provide your own brushes, palette, etc. Firing can not be done at the site and will be arranged in class by local members to fire the first 2 times. You will be returning home with a wet piece so bring an appropriate container to house the piece.

Lodging is available near the school site. Please call if you need help finding accommodations.
